Earn money towards your tuition with using Scrip!

The Scrip program has proved itself valuable not only to Zanesville Christian School but also to our parents. Some of our parents have had almost two school payments covered by using scrip cards. The total amount scrip has generated in just over a

year's time is over \$8,000! This is with approximately only ten families participating on a regular basis. Much of the waiting and work has been taken out of the scrip program with *scripnow* and gift cards being kept in stock in our school office. *Scripnow* allows you to purchase and print gift cards immediately to stores like JCPenney's, Home Depot, and CVS. You can also purchase gift cards in the office from these stores: Bob Evans, Cracker Barrel, Creno's Pizza, Pick-n-

Save, Walmart, Land's End (Kmart,Sears,The Great Indoors), Wendy's, Starbucks, and Dutch Hospitality group. Here is an example of how this could work: Let's say you need tires on your car. You buy one Land's End card (for Sears) of \$400. This will put \$64.00 (16%) back into the scrip account. Fiftypercent of this will go to the school and the other half will be credited toward your tuition. **Please** take advantage of this program to help you and the school this coming year.
